

Preventive Maintenance (PM) Schedule for Load and Pack Vehicles

Program must be followed to retain warranty coverage

Driver Daily Safety Checklist and report any problems every shift:

- 1. Walk around vehicle
- 2. Check for tire inflation/wear
- 3. Look for fluid leaks under vehicle
- 4. Check for trash blocking radiator area
- 5. Follow the cab decal for your daily inspections requirements
- 6. Check washer fluid/wiper blades
- 7. Check reverse beeper-audible.
- 8. Go thru the "Daily Inspection Requirements" decal, inside cab

"A" PM Services to be performed every 250 engine meter hours

- 1. Replace engine oil/filter
- 2. Clean battery terminals
- 3. Check drive chains and sprockets for wear (see Kit Program)
- 4. check belts for excessive wear

"B" PM Services to be performed every 500 engine meter hours

- 1. Perform all items on "A" PM check list, Plus:
- 2. Check Morse control cables
- 3. Replace fuel filter as required but annually
- 4. Check/inspect foot treadle/pedal
- 5. Drain and refill Hyd. fluid/replace filter

"C" PM Services to be performed every 750 engine meter hours

- 1. Rebuild or replace major components and parts that are just worn out and on their last leg/not repairable:
 - A. Drive Chains and sprockets yearly or if needed sooner (see Kit Program)
 - B. Wind screens and/or whiskers (brushes) (see Kit Program)
 - C. Hvd. hoses
 - D. Grip arm assembly (see Kit descriptions Program)
 - E. Sprocket arm assembly " " "
 F. Top pivot assembly " " "
 G. Lift chains " " "
 H. Lift Guide blocks " " " "
 I. Slide block " " "
